

Hospital Bill Help

Maine Hospitals must provide Free Care if you qualify.



Who can get Free Care?

You have the right to get “medically necessary” care at any hospital in Maine, even if you can’t pay for it. Depending on your household income, you can get care free. **Some hospitals offer sliding scale discounts too.** Look at the chart on the back page to see who can get Free Care or Sliding-Scale care, and where to get it.



What services can I get?

Hospitals must provide Free Care to eligible people for “medically necessary” hospital services. Most Sliding-Scale Care programs also cover “medically necessary services.” This may not include things like lab work. You can call a hospital to find out what services are covered.



How do I apply?

Call the hospital and ask for the billing or financial services department. Ask how Free and Sliding-Scale Care works. They may help you fill out the application. Some hospitals ask you to apply for MaineCare first.

What if they deny my application?

Call our HelpLine at 1-800-965-7476 for other ideas to help with health care costs. We can also tell you how you can appeal the hospital’s denial if you think you should qualify.



How do they count my income?

The hospital may ask you for pay stubs, tax returns or other documents to prove your income. You may qualify if your income is under the limit for the past 12 months **OR** the past 3 months. If you don’t qualify one way, you may qualify the other way. For example, looking at the last 3 months may help people with higher yearly income if their income dropped in the 3 months before the application.
